The **Transfiguration of Jesus** is an event in the New Testament in which Jesus is transfigured becoming radiant in glory upon a mountain. The Gospels of Matthew 17:1-9, Mark 9:2-8, and Luke 9:28-36 describe it, and 2 Peter 1:16-18 refers to it. The Gospel of John alludes to it in John 1:14. Through each of these recollections the glory of the Lord is revealed in Jesus Christ. Where do you see Christ in your life?
